16	Q. Who were the partners at the firm
17	when you joined?
18	A. Paul Traub, Harold Bonacquist and
19	Dwight Young.
20	Q. Concerning eToys bankruptcy, do you
21	know of who at TB&F, if anyone, spoke to eToys
22	or anybody representing eToys concerning the
23	retention of Barry gold?
24	A. Yes.

1	Q. Who would that be, please?
2	A. I think it would have been myself,
3	Susan Balaschak and/or Paul Traub.

 - Q. What has been your association with Mr. Gold since then? I mean, has it become a person relationship? Is it strictly business relationship?
